- Your German exchange student should come to school whenever your child has to be there—unless they have to be there earlier due to a field trip or a presentation at the Middle School.

- These activities are optional (except for Oktoberfest!), and all are welcome! It is also possible that just your German student participates.
- If you want more specific information about the activity, please contact the parent who volunteered to organize the event.

FIELD TRIPS

- For any field trip, please provide the German student with a lunch or lunch money (unless otherwise indicated).
- For trips into Boston and Harvard, please provide your student with money (small bills and/or coins) to pay for the Commuter Rail and the T. A round-trip ticket for the Commuter Rail is \$10.50 and the single fare for the T is \$2.00.*
- After the Harvard and Boston trips, the students will always return to the Wellesley Hills Commuter Rail station at 3:12pm and walk back to WHS to be picked up there.
- Each WHS student will be allowed to go on ONE field trip. Field trip sign up sheets and permission slips will be available in room 313. Sign-ups are first come, first served. Students must produce a signed permission slip and check for admission costs (made out to Wellesley Public Schools GAPP account) on the day after sign-up or their space will be given to the next person on the waiting list.

**If you are hosting a German student, but your own student is NOT going to Germany, you are NOT responsible for paying for transportation—that is the German student's responsibility. This has been explained to the students and they should have the funds to pay for their own transportation.*

- Each German student is covered by a special insurance for the GAPP exchange—however, they do not have any insurance cards etc. In the unlikely situation that you cannot get in touch with Frau Sieck or Frau Ellis, please fill out the paperwork to the best of your knowledge. The student should pay for any small expenses out of his/her own pocket. If the expense is beyond that of what the student has with him/her and you still cannot get in contact with either Frau Sieck or Frau Ellis, please cover the upfront expense until Frau Sieck can reimburse you.
